Tech Tips – Encrypt an Output File

- Did you know you can encrypt an output file in IBM SPSS Statistics?
- Encrypting an output file ensures that only those who have access to a password can access or change the file, ensuring the security of your data.

Tech Tips – Encrypt an Output File

- When saving an output file you can encrypt it.
- Go to **File > Save as**.
- Provide a File name and tick **Encrypt file with password**. Click **Save**.
- Provide a password and click **OK**. When you open the file later you will need to provide a password.
- ***Please note that the password is not recoverable if lost or forgotten.***
