- In IBM SPSS Statistics Version 28, users can go to the **File** menu and search for the **Welcome Dialogue**.



- On the right side of the Welcome Dialogue is the What's New section. Here users can use the small blue arrows for touring new features in IBM SPSS Statistics.
- In this example, the new option for violin plots. Users can use the arrow buttons to see further features. This makes seeing new features super easy!
